CARACTERÍSTICAS TÉCNICAS / SILLAS

BACKREST

Bench for collectivities. Monocoque of bentwood slats of 15 mm. thick. Made of natural beech veneer. The beech carcasses are finished in natural varnished, in any other tone or lacquered in a color to be determined. Optionally it can be manufactured in board with high pressure laminate and phenolic resins of 13 mm. thick with black core and white surface finish. The front part is finished with upholstered panel on plywood board with non-deformable high density foam. Fabric to choose from the full range of FORTY DESIGN.

SEAT

Upholstered on monocoque. by means of upholstered panel on plywood board with high density non-deformable foam. Fabric to choose from the full range of FORTY DESIGN.

STRUCTURE

Legs made of solid beech wood finished in the same color as the casing. The legs are joined together by means of a folded metal plate screwed to the casing, which provides stability and rigidity to the whole. Finished in aluminum-colored epoxy paint.
